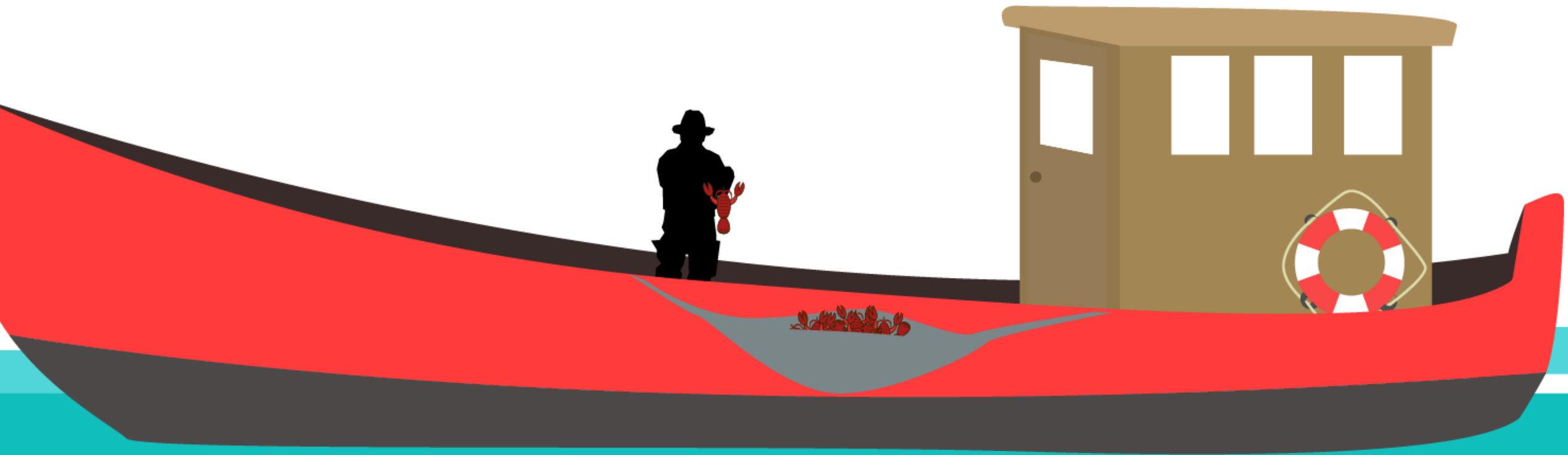


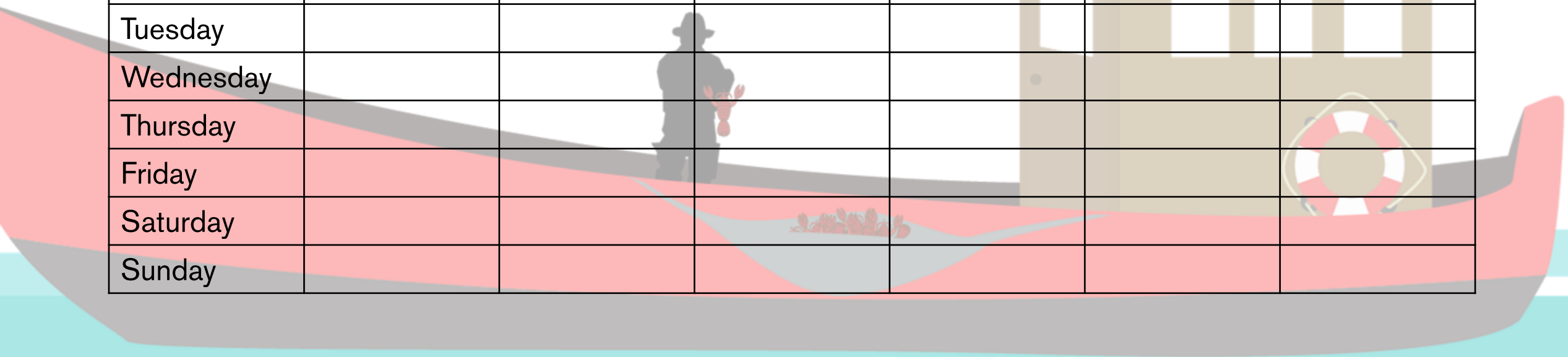
Lobster Pots



If needed, start by setting up your paper...



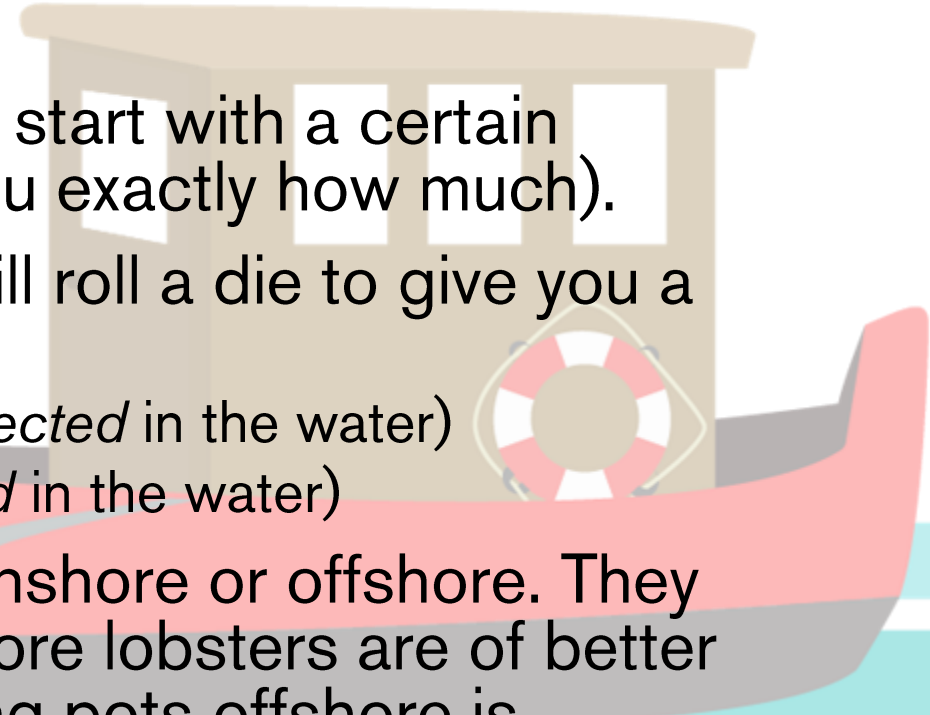

How to Play



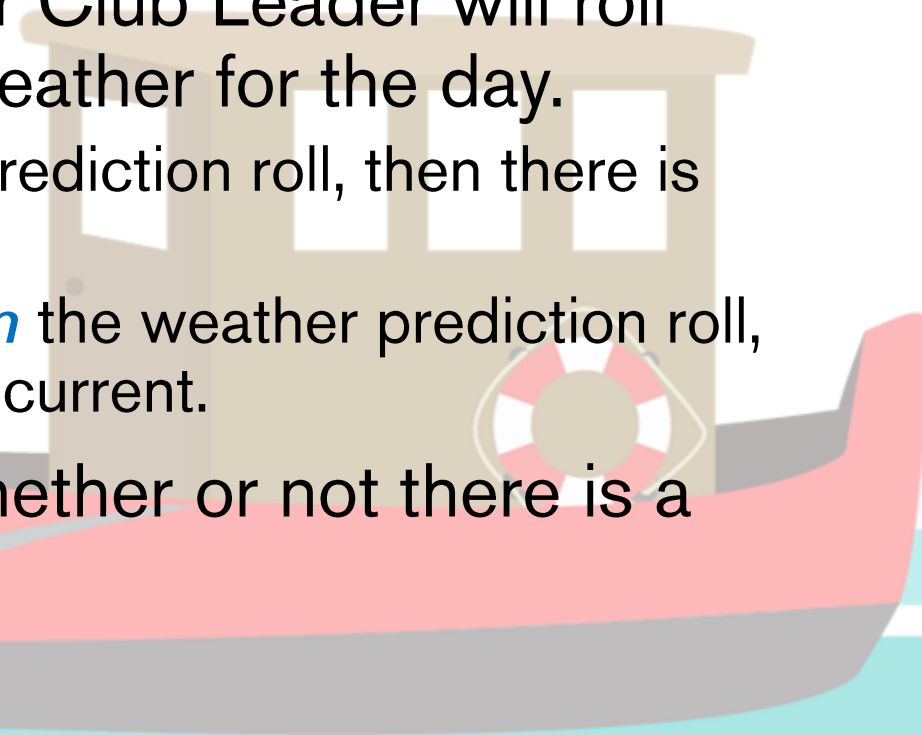
- You own your own lobster business! The goal of the game is to make as much money (profit) in one week as possible.
- You can afford to have 6 lobster pots, and you start with a certain amount of money (your Club Leader will tell you exactly how much).
- On each day of the week, your Club Leader will roll a die to give you a weather forecast.
 - 1, 2, 3 = good weather *expected* (no currents *expected* in the water)
 - 4, 5, 6 = bad weather *expected* (currents *expected* in the water)
- Now, you must place your lobster pots either inshore or offshore. They do *not* all need to be in the same place! Offshore lobsters are of better quality (and make you more money), but placing pots offshore is riskier...



How to Play



- Once you have placed all of your pots, your Club Leader will roll another die, which will tell you the actual weather for the day.
 - If the number rolled is *less than* the weather prediction roll, then there is *bad weather*, and therefore, a current!
 - If the number rolled is *equal to or greater than* the weather prediction roll, then there is *good weather*, and therefore, no current.
- You earn and lose money depending on whether or not there is a current and where your pots are placed...

How to Play

No Current	Inshore	Offshore
Money Earned (per pot)	\$2	\$6
Money Lost (per pot)	\$0	\$0

Current	Inshore	Offshore
Money Earned (per pot)	\$4	\$0
Money Lost (per pot)	\$0	-\$10

When there is a current and your pots are offshore, the pots are destroyed. You must always have 6 pots, so you must replace any destroyed for \$10 apiece. This is why you lose \$10 per pot with an offshore current.

How to Play



Calculate how much money you've earned and lost and fill in your table for the day. Here's an example (starting with \$50):

Day	Pots Inshore	Pots Offshore	Current	Money Earned	Money Lost	Balance
Monday	4	2	Yes	\$16	\$20	\$46

The game ends at the end of the day on Sunday. The lobster business with the most money (profit) is the winner!

How to Play (Optional)

Some days are special:

- **Tuesdays** are **lottery days**. You will write down a number between 2 and 12 on a piece of paper. Then, your Club Leader will roll 2 dice. The sum of the numbers on the dice is the winning number, and the winner(s) gets \$100!
- On **Thursdays**, you must **pay taxes**. Taxes are calculated as a percentage of the profit you have made so far. For example, if you started with \$50 and have \$90 on Thursday, you must pay taxes on your \$40 of profit. Your Club Leader will tell you what percent of your profit will be taken out for taxes.
- On **Saturdays**, you can **earn interest** on your money as if it were in a bank. Your Club Leader will tell you what percent interest you can earn.
